

# What's Happening at Your Health Service

## MAIN ENTRANCE

To maintain a higher level of safety for our clients and visitors using the main entrance to enter or leave the facility, bollards have been installed in the concrete apron leading to the door, to restrict vehicle access to the area.

However some issues are still being experienced with bicycles being parked by the front entrance. Bicycle racks have been installed adjacent to the entry – cyclists are asked to utilise these to ensure the area is restricted to pedestrian traffic.

## PRIMARY CARE

Following the recent official opening, all of our Primary Care services have now moved into their new rooms in the Primary Care wing. Access to this area is via the main entrance in Village Drive. Clients attending appointments are asked to present at reception, from where they will be directed to the appropriate area by REDHS staff.
