What: REDHS advises of the resignation of the current CEO, Anne McEvoy

When: Effective date 23 August 2019

The REDHS CEO, Anne McEvoy has provided the Board of Directors with her resignation to take effect 23 August 2019. This was accepted by the Board.

Anne has provided outstanding service to Rochester Elmore District Health Service and its community over the past eight years as both Director of Clinical Services Sep 2011-March 2014 and as CEO March 2014 to 23 August 2019.

During this time she has accomplished the following impressive results:

As Chief Executive Officer:

- Responsibility for budget of \$14.2M, including 12 cost centres and staffing of 120 FTE, headcount of 225.
- Provision of high level advice to Board of Directors including analysis of internal and external environments, maintaining key relationships with funders
- Implementing, monitoring and reporting to the REDHS Board of Directors on the REDHS 2020 Strategic Plan
- Guiding and directing the development of REDHS service plan to support the next 10 years of service delivery focus for the community
- Led the growth of services in the strategic targets of primary and aged care
- Met all compliance related obligations.

As Director of Clinical Services:

- Increased residential aged care respite bed days by 25% from 2011/12 financial year to 2013/14
- Established and/or expanded exercise physiology, allied health assistant, and social worker and occupational therapy services at REDHS. Secured contracts for the delivery of the National Respite for Carers program with Uniting Aged Care and an agreement with Villa Maria to provide home care services.
- Developed successful funding submissions through Vic Outreach to provide allied health service to Dingee and from LMMML for mental health services to Rochester and Elmore.
- Enhanced relationships with general practitioners in the three medical practices in Rochester and Elmore exemplified by graduate nurse contract with



St Anthony's Medical practice and also securing additional radiology services as a direct result of GP request for increased services. .

- Lead the emergency management coordination as a result of an internal emergency through flood damage at the Hostel in July 2013. Enacted an emergency management team to support the safety of resident including the relocation of 8 residents.
- Workforce development initiatives, graduate nurse, graduate allied health, AHA = project, EN and ASM projects.
