

## **Next Steps - Application to Residential Aged Care at REDHS Yalukang Aged Care**

So you now have had a site tour and met the lovely residents and staff at Yalukang and have chosen to make this your new home. What to do now....

**My Aged Care Assessment** – Contact My Aged Care to be assessed for services, this assessment is required for approval to enter a funded Aged Care Facility. Please ensure you request services for...

- Respite
- Permanent Residency
- Transitional Care
- Home Care

**Medical Review** - Arrange a Health and cognitive Health check up by your GP, General Medical Practitioner, and have them write up a review for you to submit with your application. If you don't have a local GP Rochester and Elmore have some lovely Practitioners, please contact Yalukang Reception for details on how to contact them. We need to ensure that we as a facility are capable of meeting all your needs, so this information is vital before we proceed any further.

**Services Australia/My Aged Care Income and Asset Evaluation** – contact either Services Australia or My Aged Care and arrange an income and asset evaluation, they will then supply you with a statement that will show which category you fall into for fees and payments.

**Make an appointment with a Clinical Care Coordinator or our Aged Care Manager at REDHS Yalukang Aged Care** - The clinical care coordinator will complete the Pre-Admission Information form with you and explain the admission pack. This is a mandatory assessment and once completed a copy will be kept on our file and one supplied to you in your admission pack.

Submit your admission pack to Yalukang Reception to place you on our waiting list and we will contact you to make an appointment with the Business Support Coordinator.
